We further agree to incorporate the wording of Exhibit A on the back page of any primary printed materials (such as programs, bulletins, brochures) to be used or distributed at the event to be held at UCC. The size of the statement in Exhibit A shall be proportional to the size of other statements in the material, but in no case smaller than 10 point type. This requirement can be waived only by a UCC minister, whose signature must be affixed below.
